The catch is – "tomorrow" is actually *today*.

Many are missing the opportunity happening right in front of them.

It's time songwriters stop chasing dreams of radio play and CD sales – that is "yesterday" thinking.

<u>Don't chase the 100 they play on the radio. Sow seeds to the 100,000+ that</u> <u>are equally as talented, with followings online and across the world.</u>

With the creative opportunities available in sync licensing, your song could be played for millions on the Internet while you receive traditional royalties.

Of course, if a popular artist picks up your song and it receives radio play, that is FANTASTIC! And we have a number of writers for whom that has happened. But if you want to get in the game *right now* and start making an impact with your music, we think "tomorrow" thinking is the right approach.

With that in mind, let's talk about the steps you need to take to get your song in the right hands in this new reality.

Step 1: Write a Great Song

The MOST important process of getting your song out there is writing an awesome song that **needs** to be heard.

Everyone has it in them... but the problem sometimes is trying to pen that perfect song.

Begin searching for inspiration all over the place! Think of past life experiences and what those experiences taught you.

Every song is different and they don't all start the same.

You may come up with a catchy melody first, a few lyrics, or a clever hook to base the song around.

Wherever you start, write down every idea you have.

The idea you have in passing that you may brush off as something unnecessary could lead you to write that next hit song.

(Hint: Be sure to open your voice memos app on your phone or whatever device you can use to record yourself and sing that melody you've been humming all day.)

Once you get started, make sure you develop your rhyme scheme and get your tempo down.

And if you get stuck, be sure to use resources like thesaurus.com, dictionary.com, and rhymer.com...

There are endless resources available at your fingertips to help you write your song.

Step 2: Create an Awesome Demo

Earlier we talked about recording yourself on your phone, or recording device, singing your song.

That is considered a "worktape" and is the first step in having a professional demo created!

When "pitching" your song, artists are more likely to <u>sit down and listen to</u> <u>your song</u> if you have a <u>professional demo</u> created because they are able to imagine what the song might sound like in a finished form over the radio and on their upcoming projects.

Creating great-sounding demos has always been tricky because it requires years of networking and personally seeking out professional musicians and vocalists which is not always easy to do, and you may not know where to start...

Here at BuyDemoTracks.com we have simplified this process for you!

Our website allows you to custom-build a demo using industry-leading musicians and vocalists. We also offer <u>competitive demo packages</u> with a 50% discount for all Songfuel members.

All you do is pick who you want to perform on your demo from our BDT Marketplace and we handle the rest!

We will listen to your worktape, create an arrangement, communicate with the selected musicians, and they will then create your track and even offer songwriting suggestions if needed and help with melodies.

Then, we send the track to your selected vocalist to sing on your song, produce, tune, mix and master the demo before sending it back to you. You might even get the chance to commercially release your song and feature

the artist, or have the artist take the song and release it under their brand!

We will then upload your song to our Song Library for you to start promoting and monetizing your demo.

Step 3: Upload to BuyDemoTracks.com

The next step is to get the song in front of potential artists for recording! This is where BuyDemoTracks.com excels.

While many of our writers have their song cut and released in the demo process itself (more info available <u>here</u>), often the writer wants to place the song in our library so it can be discovered by more artists and performers.

As a member of Songfuel, you will have five (5) monthly upload credits which can be used to place songs in our library.

(Have a demo you didn't record with us? You can upload that too!)

The BDT Song Library - which we call SongRadar - has a plethora of songs from a growing number of genres, and is constantly being updated with <u>new</u> songs being added regularly.

Artists can search through our library using filters such as genre, tempo, time signature, key, lyrics, and more!

It is an incredible resource for live performers, recording artists, and music leaders of all kinds to find that next song they need for their upcoming production and **your song could be the one they choose**!

Step 4: Promote Your Music & Earn Passive Income

Although the vision has expanded, BuyDemoTracks.com was originally born out of one simple problem: Songwriters are spending money to cut great demos, but once a song gets picked up and cut by an artist, those professional demo tracks were essentially dead.
